

NCAA Rules Commonly asked questions ¹

What are the rules about recruits and alcohol?

The recruit and their host cannot consume alcohol regardless of age.

Can we take a recruit to an event with alcohol present, such as an event on the Downtown Mall?

Yes, BUT the recruit and the host cannot consume any alcohol.

What about 21+ venues?

No, you cannot take a recruit anywhere they cannot LEGALLY enter.

What are the rules about recruits and drugs?

No drugs under any circumstances.

What are the rules about recruits and Social Networking?

You cannot publically post about a recruit until they have signed their National Letter of Intent

What if I am posting about something outside of sports?

You can contact a recruit on social media if the post does not entail any details about the recruits visit, verbal commitment, or recruitment process. Ideally, this would be done privately through private messaging.

What happens once they sign their National Letter of Intent?

Post away.

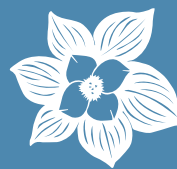
