Acting as student-host is an important service at Mercyhurst University and the Department of Athletics. The following is a brief list of NCAA and Mercyhurst policies regarding the hosting of prospects. After reviewing, if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask either your coach or the Assistant Athletics Director for Compliance/SWA: Stacey Gaudette.

1. Student-hosts cannot provide alcohol or drugs to the prospective student-athlete.
2. A maximum of \$30 per day shall be provided for entertainment, excluding the cost of meals and admissions to campus athletic events. An additional \$15 per day may be provided for each additional prospect the host entertains.
3. No cash may be given to the student-host or prospect.
4. Meal cards for the on-campus dining venues will be distributed by your coach. Coaches can provide food and other entertainment options to student-hosts for off-campus experiences.
5. The entertainment funds may not be used to purchase the prospect souvenirs (t-shirts, hats, etc.).
6. You may not use vehicles provided or arranged for by an institutional staff member or booster.
7. All entertainment must take place within a 30-mile radius of Mercyhurst University.
8. You must be enrolled at Mercyhurst University. If you are a freshman, the NCAA Initial Eligibility Center must have certified you as either a qualifier or partial qualifier.
9. The prospect can participate in recreational activities: provided the activities are not organized or observed by members of the coaching staff and are not designed to test the prospect's athletic abilities.
10. You shall not allow recruiting conversations to occur, on or off campus, between the prospect and a booster.
11. Complimentary admissions to an on-campus event may be provided to the prospect and the prospect's parents (or guardians). Please see your coach to be placed on the ticket list.
