




- C.A.R.E. Team

Social Norms Campaign

Goal

Educate student-athletes on topics relevant to them with interesting, easy to read visuals

Logistics

- The posters will be distributed at the beginning of each month around UCFAA
- Each poster will relate to the specific C.A.R.E. meeting topic of that month





Key Benefits

- Provides student-athletes with information about applicable topics on a monthly basis
- Creative posters catch attention of student-athletes and are easily accessible for student athletes to see (displayed in study hall, training rooms, and locker rooms)
- Guest speaker will serve to motivate, encourage, and prepare student athletes to act responsibly


